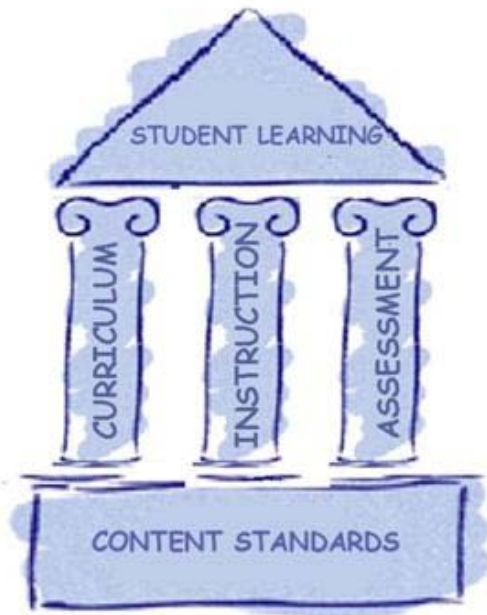


Southwest Georgia RESA

All sessions will begin at 8:30 a.m. with sign-in at the Frank McCoy, Jr. Educational Center in Pelham. Lunch break will begin at 11:15 a.m. and participants will move to the Walker-Inman Campus in Camilla to participate in demonstration lessons in the Model Classrooms.

Each participant will sign in at 12:30 p.m. in the Model Classroom. Participants will need to bring lunch or make arrangements to have lunch from 11:15 a.m. to 12:30p.m. Demonstration lessons begin promptly at 12:30 p.m.

To earn 2 PLU's for Standards Based Classroom Training,

1. Each participant will be required to **write a lesson plan** using the Lesson Plan Framework, provided at the SBC Training.
2. Each participant will have the **lesson observed by a school or system person.**
3. Each participant will **turn in their observation to the System Curriculum Director, deadline to be set by system.**
4. The collected observations will be turned in to RESA by the Planning Committee Meeting on **April 21, 2010.** This documentation will provide evidence of aligning instruction to standards and assessing the implementation of standards based classrooms.
5. Southwest Georgia RESA will issue transcript to participants for 2 PLU's.
